## High School Visual Arts

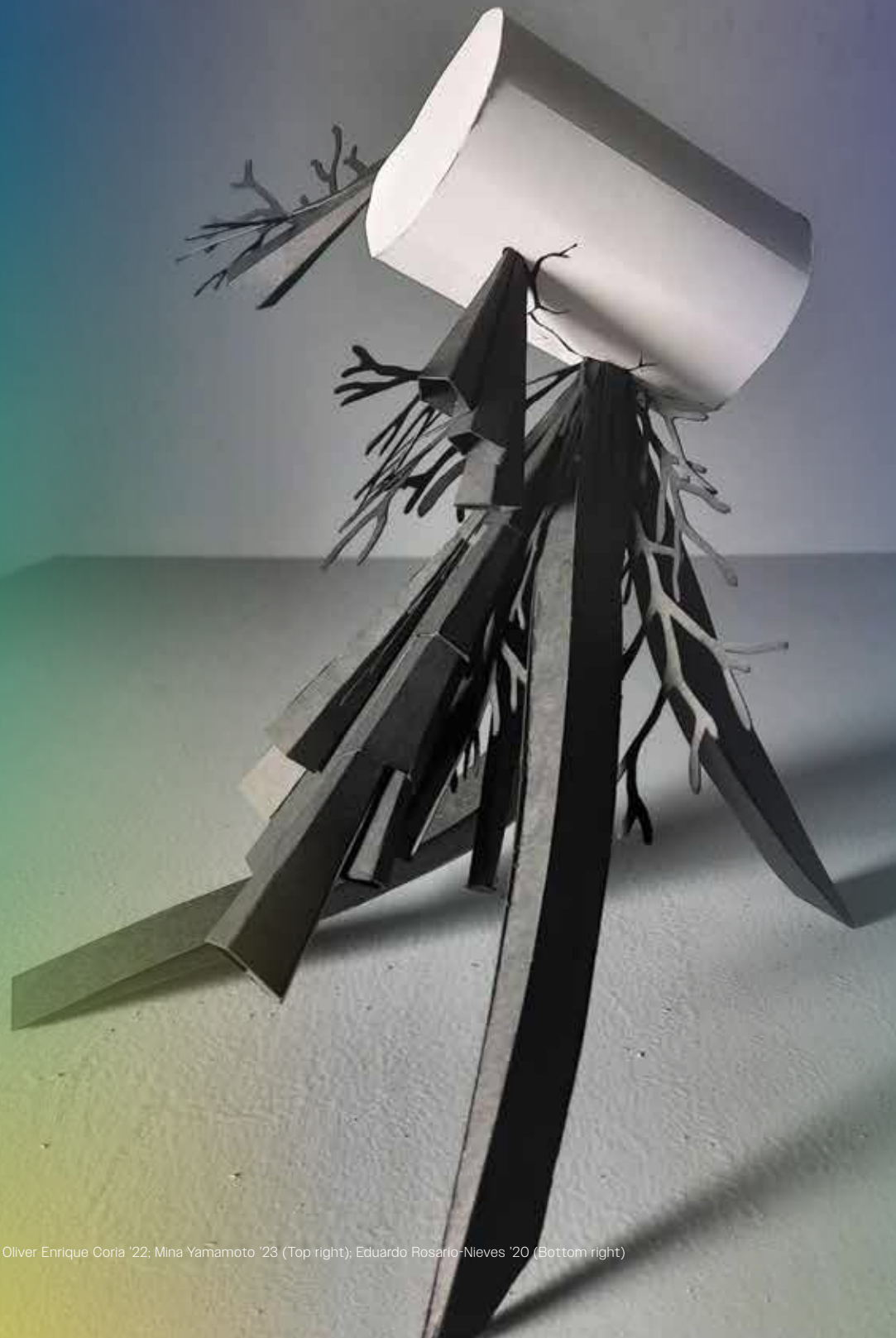

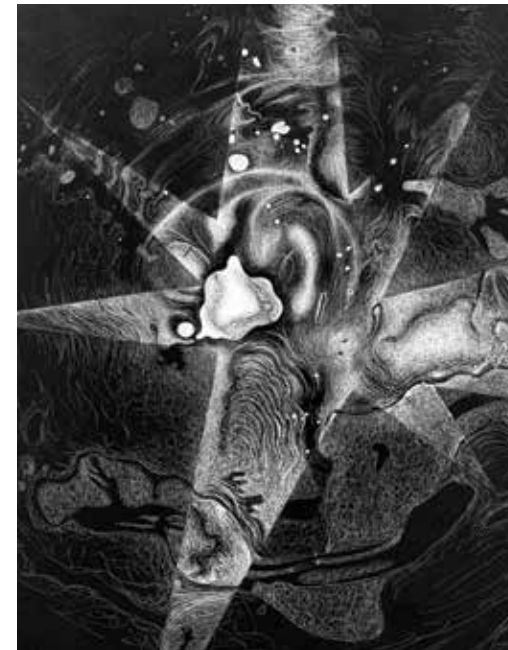

## BUILD YOUR FOUNDATION

During their first year, students take three studio art courses each semester: design, drawing and sculpture. These classes place emphasis on developing foundational art and design skills in a variety of media, employing an appropriate art and design vocabulary, and using classroom critiques to encourage analysis and self-evaluation.



## THEN TAKE IT TO THE NEXT LEVEL

In the second year, studio art courses in design, drawing, painting and sculpture continue at an advanced level. Students also are required to take AP Art History. Although structure and technique are addressed in studio courses, greater emphasis is placed on the interpretive style of each individual and the development of a professional portfolio.
