DETERMINE SEVERITY OF INJURY

NOT SEVERE

.. to determine if an ambulance/EMS will be needed immediately.

YES, SEVERE INJURY/CONDITION

Head injury, unconsciousness, severe bleeding, breathing difficulties, a joint/limb that is obviously deformed or severed, or other serious medical condition...

CALL UNCSA POLICE

IMMEDIATELY CALL UNCSA POLICE

Or, use our Safety App (RAVE Guardian);
Or, if outside, activate emergency call box.

GIVE NEEDED INFORMATION

Ambulance is needed
Location and nature of the medical emergency
Name of injured subject
Answer any questions

If the injury or condition is not severe enough to require an ambulance/EMS response:

During normal business hours Monday-Friday, and the injured party needs to be transported to **Health Services, call Health Services at (336) 770-3288.**

Outside of normal business hours, call **UNC Nurse Connect 984-364-4730** and follow the instructions given by the nurse on call.
